Thinking about ISO certification but not sure where you stand? This self-assessment tool is designed to help manufacturers honestly evaluate their current position against the most common ISO standards, before committing to a formal certification pathway.

HOW TO USE THIS TOOL

This is not an audit. It's a structured self-assessment to help you understand where your current operations sit relative to ISO requirements. For each area, indicate your current position using the scale below.

- A** Already in place, documented and followed
- B** In place but not consistently documented
- C** Informal or partially in place
- D** Not currently in place

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PART 1: ISO 9001 QUALITY MANAGEMENT

ISO 9001 is the world's most widely adopted quality management standard and the most common certification requirement in commercial and government procurement.

- We have identified the internal and external factors that affect our ability to deliver quality products and services.
- We understand the needs and expectations of our key customers and stakeholders.
- The scope of our quality management activities is defined.

LEADERSHIP & PLANNING

- Senior leadership is visibly committed to quality, not just operationally responsible for it.
- We have a documented quality policy that is communicated to all staff.
- Quality objectives are set, measurable, and reviewed regularly.
- Risks and opportunities that could affect quality are identified and managed.

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OPERATIONS

- Our key production and service delivery processes are documented.
- We have defined quality requirements for our products and services.
- We control externally provided products and services (suppliers, subcontractors).
- Inspection and testing activities are defined and records are maintained.

PERFORMANCE & IMPROVEMENT

- Customer satisfaction is monitored and reviewed.

- Management reviews the QMS at planned intervals.

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PART 2: ISO 45001 WORK HEALTH & SAFETY

ISO 45001 provides the framework for managing work health and safety risks and opportunities. It is increasingly required or preferred in construction, manufacturing, mining, and government supply chains.

LEADERSHIP & WORKER PARTICIPATION

- Senior leadership demonstrates active commitment to WHS, not just delegated responsibility.
- Workers are consulted in WHS decisions that affect them.
- A documented WHS policy exists and is communicated.

HAZARD IDENTIFICATION & RISK CONTROL

- Hazards are identified proactively through a structured process.
- Risks are assessed and controls are implemented using a hierarchy of controls.
- Legal and regulatory WHS requirements are identified and monitored.
- Emergency preparedness plans are in place and tested.

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INCIDENTS, NON-CONFORMANCES & CORRECTIVE ACTION

- All incidents and near-misses are reported, investigated, and recorded.
- Corrective actions address root causes, not just immediate fixes.
- WHS performance data is reviewed at management level.

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PART 3: ISO 14001 ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

ISO 14001 is the international standard for environmental management systems. It is increasingly relevant for manufacturers with significant waste, energy, water, or emissions footprints, and is a growing requirement in ESG-focused procurement.

- Environmental aspects and impacts of our operations are identified and documented.
- Legal and regulatory environmental obligations are identified and complied with.
- Environmental objectives are set and monitored.
- We have processes to prevent pollution and manage environmental incidents.
- Environmental performance is reviewed at management level.
